Kalwall solves the problem of how to transmit useable natural daylight into pools and sports halls. Kalwall is quite different to other light transmitting products because it diffuses evenly distributed daylight into the building – without the glare and stark contrasts of light and shade produced by conventional glazing.

In sports halls, playing, exercising and recreational conditions are dramatically improved with the natural daylight Kalwall provides - no more artificially-lit black boxes!

In swimming pools, Kalwall enhances the ambience, provides privacy and improves swimmer safety through reduced veiling glare from the surface of the water.

Kalwall means lower energy costs for artificial light, heating and air-conditioning. It reduces or eliminates the need for blinds, curtains or external solar control devices.

Kalwall was introduced to UK architects in 1997, from the USA where it has been widely used for many years. Since then nearly 400 walling and roofing projects have been completed for almost every type of private and public sector building – many of them pools and sports halls.

Kalwall provides the daylighting solution – as witnessed by the comments shown on the right.
